- 2. The library hosted a noon hour meditation seminar on Sept 18th, teaching meditation on the breath, and a family seminar called Loving-Kindness on Sept 20th. Shannon Stein who has been practicing individual, couple and family therapy, was the instructor.
- 3. The library held two events in conjunction with Culture Days on sept 26th. Our annual Human Book night was a huge success, involving many library hours to organize. We had 6 Human books this year, who were all very interesting individuals. Aimee, Tara, and myself, all worked the evening event. We also hosted the "Who's Who Party" in the morning, serving seniors coffee, muffins/dainties, and juice. I completed the budget in conjunction with our permit for Mb Liquor, and we netted \$ 308.76.
