# **ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT:**

- 1. Author Reading & Workshop Wendy McGrath Sept 15<sup>th</sup> 5:45-9:00. Administrator worked this evening, with 13 individuals attending
- 2. Administrator also met with Lauren Wadelius, Administrator The Pas library on Sept 15<sup>th</sup>, to discuss our mutual concerns and S.W.O.T meetings
- 3. Administrator attended CFAR on Sept 21, interview regarding Human Book Night
- 4. The library staff celebrated Alecia's 30<sup>th</sup> Birthday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> at Racks
- 5. The library closed on Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>, to allow us to clean downstairs after the flood. Many boxes that were placed on the floor in the Kinsmen room had to be moved, as well as dep cleaning after all the water.

- 6. Oct 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>-no school, very high traffic both days.
- 7. Library staff were very busy the week of Sept 26<sup>th</sup>, leading up to Culture Days on Sept 30th. The building was decorated, programs made, interviews and pictures of all Human Books, obtaining liquor license, purchasing all the cheese and crackers, as well as breakfast items for Author Reading, picked up wine, un-hook front desk computers, and hook all back up, returned unopened wine, Facebook and Web-Page updates, and decorate outside the day of the event.
